# *Instrumental Music Student Responsibilities*

Please read over the following responsibilities of instrumental music students with your child. We hope that you will become actively involved by supporting and encouraging your child to learn to play a musical instrument. Please sign and return the MUSIC CONTRACT to the school.

1. Students are expected to participate in the instrumental music program for the **entire** school year. Winners never quit and quitters never win.
2. Students are expected to practice their instruments at home weekly.
3. Students are expected to bring their instruments and book to school on days when music classes are scheduled, and are to report to band or orchestra without being reminded by the teacher.
4. Students are required to attend all scheduled music programs or concerts unless he or she is ill. Failure to attend the instrumental (and choir concert if a member) will result in a grade drop and non-participation in the end-of-year party/event.
5. Students are responsible for taking care of their instruments and for having all necessary supplies – (reeds, rosin, valve oil, etc...)
6. Students understand that they will receive an effort grade for band or orchestra that will reflect their homework, performance and concert attendance.



# Instrumental Music Grading Policy

Each student in the instrumental music program will receive an effort grade on his/her quarterly report card. The grade will reflect their effort in two or three categories. The three categories are Homework, Testing, and Concert attendance.

The following chart shows how the student will earn their grade during each quarter of school.

**HOMEWORK** - Each quarter a student must turn in one homework/practice sheet. You are required to sign off that your child has practiced their instrument at home at least 3 times during this quarter. Students are allowed to turn in more than one sheet per quarter for a special reward, but still must turn in one sheet every nine weeks of school.

**TEST** - Each student will also be tested in class on various pieces of music every quarter. Ask them if they are prepared.

**CONCERT** - Each student will be given credit for attending the Winter and Spring concerts. These are mandatory so be on the look-out for dates to these events. (6<sup>th</sup> grade students also have a 3<sup>rd</sup> concert that is NOT counted for grades, but is still mandatory. This is the AREA concert that usually takes place at the end of January.)

The report card will have a listing of my name below the regular teacher's name. Then it will have one of three EFFORT grades listed next to the music subject.

O = Outstanding

S = Satisfactory

N = Needs Improvement

A chart is on the wall in the music room showing each students progress in fulfilling their grades. The student can always look to see what they have completed or need to complete. If you have any questions, please contact me.



# Instrumental Music Recommended Supplies

The recommended book we use is: Essential Elements for Band / Strings (Book 1). Make sure the *correct instrument name* is listed at the top of the book. The following are recommended supplies for each instrument:

<b>BARITONE/TUBA</b>	<b>AL CASS or FAT CAT valve oil, tuning slide grease</b>
<b>CLARINET</b>	<b>One box Rico Royal #2.5 reeds, cork grease, weighted cloth</b>
<b>FLUTE</b>	<b>Small soft cloth</b>
<b>FRENCH HORN</b>	<b>Soft cloth, rotor oil, tuning slide grease</b>
<b>PERCUSSION</b>	<b>Size 2B snare sticks</b>
<b>SAXOPHONE</b>	<b>One box Rico Royal #2.5 reeds, neck strap, cork grease</b>
<b>STRINGS</b>	<b>Soft cloth, KAFKO rosin, RESONANS shoulder rest</b>
<b>TROMBONE</b>	<b>TROMBONTINE slide cream, small spray bottle</b>
<b>TRUMPET</b>	<b>AL CASS or FAT CAT valve oil, tuning slide grease</b>

A folding music stand for home practice is suggested but not required. Listed previously are some area music stores that rent instruments and sell books and supplies. I would suggest phoning these stores to be sure the items you need are in stock. ***MOST STORES ARE CLOSED ON SUNDAYS!***
